

Vision for the auditions

Young dancers auditioning for the primary school or first year of secondary school

You do not require any ballet technique or ballet experience to take part in the auditions. You will be judged on your physical abilities and talent.

Budding talents for secondary school

Second, third and fourth years of secondary education

You are required to have mastered advanced techniques in classical dance, including dancing in pointe shoes, and must meet the physical standards set.

You will participate in a classical ballet class but you need not prepare anything.

Fifth and sixth years classical dance

You must have advanced knowledge of classical ballet as well as fundamental knowledge of modern and contemporary dance.

You will be invited for a private audition following a positive reaction to your video audition.

Foreign students

Regular student

You must pass your audition and provide us with a declaration of equivalence for your study certificate from your country of origin. At the end of the sixth year, you will obtain a diploma in Arts Secondary Education (KSO).

Special advantage: Dutch lessons for students who do not speak Dutch.

If you pass your audition, but do not have an certificate of equivalence, you can register as a regular dance-only student.

Regular dance-only students

You pass your audition and have a working knowledge of French or English. You cannot take lessons in a language other than Dutch, but, depending on the country you come from, you can complete the general scholastic subjects by correspondence.
